There will be the usual social events - **Opening season drinks reception** on 2nd October, **Christmas Reception** on 11th December and **The Social Event** which is confirmed as Saturday evening 9th February 2013 at St Mary's Centre. As we were oversubscribed last season, this programme is being sent out in advance of general public release - so please return as soon as possible.

So there is every reason to walk, "Wiggins" it, or drive to The Little Theatre, The Steam Mill or St Mary's Centre over the forthcoming season on Tuesday evenings.
